What food waste can I recycle?

- ✓ Fruit and vegetable peelings
- ✓ Cooked food
- ✓ Uncooked food
- ✓ Meat/fish (including bones)
- ✓ Plate scrapings
- ✓ Cat/dog food
- ✓ Tea bags/coffee grounds



Keep it fresh as a daisy

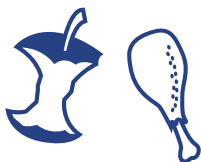
- Keep lids closed
- Use your food caddy (not your wheeled bin), otherwise your food waste could be sitting there for three weeks.

Please use newspaper or a compostable bag to line your food caddies and keep them clean.

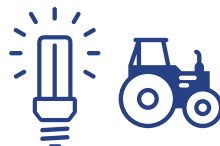
Where does my food waste go?
