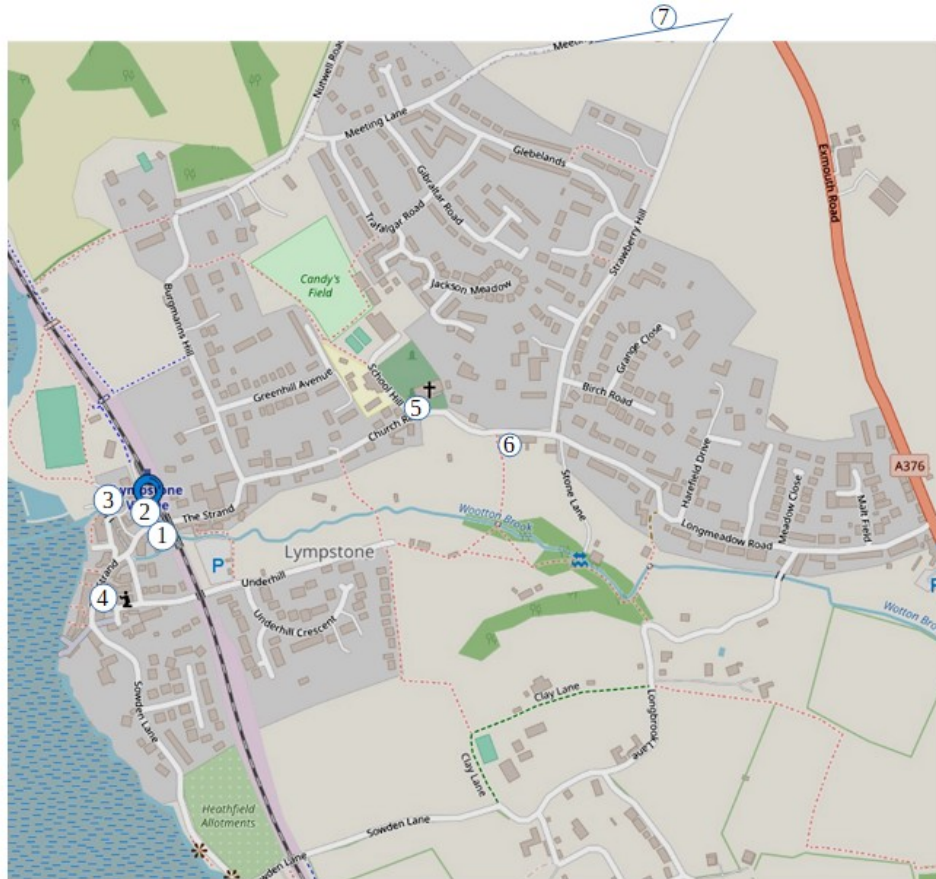

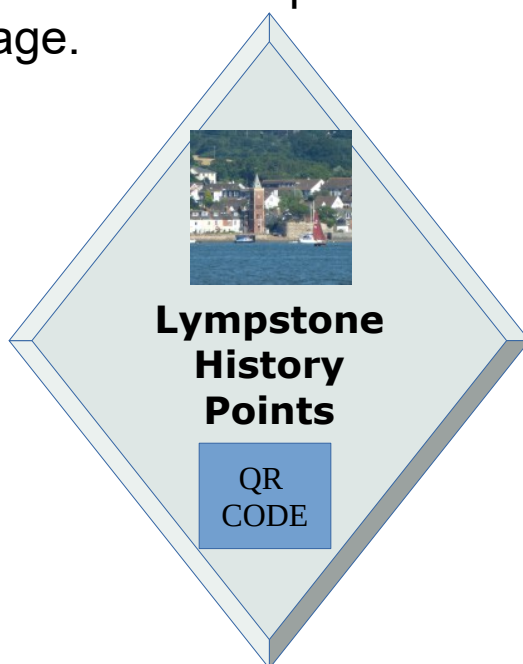


# LYMPSTONE HISTORY SOCIETY HISTORY POINTS
